Easter opening of your child's school

Your child's school remains closed. The school is open for the children of key workers and those children classed as vulnerable by the Department for Education. At this point I would like to let you know arrangements for these children during the Easter holiday period.

The Birmingham Diocesan Multi-Academy Trust (BDMAT) is committed to keeping schools open for the above children in order that as a nation we can fight the coronavirus, although the number of pupils in our schools is currently very low.

Over the Easter holiday period the school will remain open for the children of key workers and vulnerable children but on the two bank holidays (Friday 10th April and Monday 13th April) we will close the majority of our schools.

On Friday 10th April and Monday 13th April, we want to ensure that we are able to continue to provide a service for the parents of front-line NHS staff. If you are employed in the NHS and need to be in work on those days and have no other alternative care arrangements, you may book a place at one of the following sites, which will remain open:

These schools will be open to all NHS front line staff who have children in any of our schools. The schools will be open on Friday 10th April and Monday 13th April from 9:00 – 4:00pm. Parents will need to provide a packed lunch, snacks and drinks for the day.
