Free School Meal Vouchers

If you are in receipt of certain benefits you may be entitled to a Free School Meal Voucher each week worth £15 per child and are redeemable at most large supermarkets. If you think you may be entitled, please complete the form online. You may also be eligible if you are awaiting a right to stay in this country or have had a failed application too.


